## Hendre Trail Bike/Novice/Easy Trial

### Description of Event

A closed to club trial designed for solo Trail/Trial and enduro bikes and intended as a fun event. This event is held under the National Sporting Code and Standing Trials Regulations of the Auto-Cycle Union (Ltd.), these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions that may apply.

Although the venue is entirely on private land, and bikes do not have to be road-legal, no noisy or tatty field bikes will be permitted. This event is a Non Stop Trial TSR22B.

The event will consist of a main adult trial and a concurrent 'conducted' trial for young and/or inexperienced riders.

*Main Trial Classes:* Trail-Bike, Enduro, Pre-65, Trials Novice, Trials Youth.

Hard or Standard Routes

*Conducted route Classes:* Junior Expert on Expert route and Junior on Standard Route.

### Awards

No physical awards will be given but will be shown on the results. (If a series of Easy trials is run this year then points may be gained from this event for a club championship.)

### Results

Will be available on the club's website and only posted if you provide an SAE with your

entry.

### Eligibility

All riders must be West Glos. and Dean Forest MCC members – membership £5.

All riders must hold a current ACU Affiliated membership card or licence.

ACU Affiliation (Trials Registration) can be obtained by completing a form available from the ACU website [www.acu.org.uk](http://www.acu.org.uk) and returning with entry – include a photograph if no previous licence held, and the £10 fee. Please allow 2 weeks for the ACU to issue a card.

Please note: All ACU cards will be checked on the day.

### Entries

**Entry Fee: £15. (Bring correct money!)**

*Methods:* Post or deliver your fully completed entry form (The last page only of this document.) to Entries Sec together with payment and any SAE's. Or, pre-book your entry on-line then Pay on arrival (This is purely because we are late at getting regs out, don't expect to get away with late entries normally!) Details are on the event's web page ([www.wgdfmcc.org.uk](http://www.wgdfmcc.org.uk))

Are limited to 50 by order of receipt and will close when full. Confirmation of entry will be displayed on the club's website or posted if an SAE is provided.

Entry fees will only be returned in the event of cancellation or postponement for more than 24hrs, and a portion of the fee may be retained for administration costs.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.

### Riders Numbers

Will not be used so no need to remember the tape. Punch cards will be used. If we have enough observers it will make life easier, feel

free to bring one.

## **Venue**

Old Hendre Farm, Hendre, Monmouth.

The venue will be signed from the B4233 Rockfield to Abergavenny road.

## **Start time**

Starts 14:00am (Remember you need to be signed on 30 mins prior to your start time.)

## **Sections**

Standard trials marking will be used throughout – 0, 1, 2, 3, 5. Trial is a no-stopping trial (TSR22B).

There will be a harder route with variations marked with white for experienced riders.

## **Special Test**

One or more special tests may be used as a tie-breaker.

## **Tyres**

Rear tyres must be trials pattern (TSR11). Any type of front tyre may be used. Riders with ineligible rear tyre may not be allowed to start.

## **Conducted Route**

## **Course options**

Sections will be marked with blue markers on the left and red markers on the right - Junior. White gates will be for Junior Expert (hard) variations.

**ENTRY DECLARATION:** I the undersigned apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof: -

- I hereby declare that I have had the opportunity to read, and that I understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
- I further declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am competent to do so. I confirm that I understand the nature and type of event we are entering and its inherent risks and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers or officials.
