

Description of Event

The Trial will be open to affiliated members of the ACU and will be run in accordance with the National Sporting Code, the standing regulations for Trials of the Auto Cycle Union (Ltd), the following supplementary regulations and any final instructions to riders that may be issued on the day of the event. The trial will be run under non-stop rules as per TSR-22B.

This trial is also a round of the CDE Western Championship.

Venue

Coldbrook Farm, Longtown, Herefordshire. The start will be signposted off the A465 Abergavenny to Hereford road at Pandy.

Clubman marked with Red & Blue markers.

Sportsman Plus identified by a sign at the start of the section.

Sportsman variation marked with pairs of yellow markers (In accordance with Western centre guidelines).

Conducted Youth routes:

Standard Route with Red & Blue markers.

Expert variation marked with pairs of white markers.

Sections

Standard trials marking will be used throughout – 0, 1, 2, 3, 5. Trial is a no-stopping trial (TSR22B).
