### Description of Event

The Trial will be open to affiliated members of the ACU and will be run in accordance with the National Sporting Code, the standing regulations for Trials of the Auto Cycle Union (Ltd), the following supplementary regulations and any final instructions to riders that may be issued on the day of the event. The trial will be run under non-stop rules as per TSR-22B.

This trial is also a round of the CDE Western Championship.

### Venue

Coldbrook Farm, Longtown, Herefordshire. The start will be signposted off the A465 Abergavenny to Hereford road at Pandy.

### Classes

Solo Adults of all grades and Youth A, B and C can ride the main course. There will also be a separate conducted course for Youth C, D, and E riders.

**Expert** variations from Clubman route marked with pairs of white markers.

**Clubman/Expert** Identified by a sign at the start of the section.

**Clubman** marked with Red & Blue markers.

**Sportsman Plus** identified by a sign at the start of the section.

**Sportsman** variation marked with pairs of yellow markers (In accordance with Western centre guidelines).

### Conducted Youth routes:

**Standard Route** with Red & Blue markers.

**Expert** variation marked with pairs of white markers.
