Eligibility. Open to all adult members of any ACU Affiliated Club riding SOLO ENDURO, MOTO X and TRAIL motorcycles. This event will be a Hare & Hounds only which will require the rider to complete a target number of laps in each session, one of three hours and a second of two hours, the combined total will determine the results. There will be **NO SPECIAL TEST**.

Entries. To be made on the official entry form and received by the Secretary of the Meeting before Wednesday the 13th September 2006 together with an entry fee of £45. Cheques should be made payable to WTRA Ltd.

Classes: - Enduro 1 (125 2 stroke/250 4 stroke) Enduro 2 (250 2 stroke/450 4 stroke)
 Enduro 3 (250+ 2 stroke/500+ 4 stroke) for Expert, Clubman, Veteran & Sportsman classes.

Start. The start will be at the **Glyn Saer Forest** (SN 840415) just North East of Llandovery and will be signposted from the A483 at Cynghordy along the road to Tirabad. The first session of **THREE** hours will start at 10:00 hrs, the second session of **TWO** hours will start at 14:30 hrs. The results will be calculated from the overall number of laps completed during both sessions.

Scrutineering: Between 8.30 hrs & 09.30 hrs (strictly no later)

Numbers: Adhesive number plates will be supplied by the organizers & it is the rider's responsibility to ensure that they are securely fitted & kept legible during the event.

Licences: Riders must sign on and produce a current ACU License. One day ACU licenses are available for £15.

Course: All classes will compete on a 10 mile course consisting of forestry tracks. The course will be clearly marked. Where there are two markers as a gate the competitors must go between them otherwise they will be deemed to have cut the course.

Refuelling: Will be only allowed in the area identified as the refuelling area and will be marked with **GREEN** flags. Engines **MUST** be switched off in the refuel area. **NO SMOKING IN REFUELLING AREA.**

Blue Tape: There will be areas marked with blue tape which must be ridden at **WALKING PACE ONLY**. Marshals will exclude on the spot anyone disobeying this rule.

Noise: Even though the event is on private ground, noise is a sensitive issue in the area. Any bike deemed to be excessively noisy by the officials will not be allowed to start; furthermore any bike becoming excessively noisy during the event will be stopped and only allowed to continue once the problem has been fixed - you have been warned!

Tyres: There are no tyre restrictions

- I / we agree that I am / we are required to register our arrival by "signing on" at the designated place not less than 30 minutes prior to commencement of my/our practice or first competition, whichever occurs first.

Acknowledgement of the risks of motorsport: I / we understand that by taking part in this event I / we are exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I / we acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the ACU, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury I / we may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my / our voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity.
